Any registered nurse currently licensed in Texas and working as an RN in the District 9 area (including Brazoria, Chambers, Fort Bend, Galveston, Harris, Liberty, Montgomery, San Jacinto, Trinity, Walker, and Waller counties) is eligible. Anyone may nominate a registered nurse; however, self-nominations are not eligible. Previous recipients are not eligible to receive the award again but may be selected for the Lifetime Achievement Award. Criteria will be forthcoming on the TNA, District 9 website.

- Send a narrative of two (2) typed pages (or less) describing how your candidate excelled in the following areas.
- Entries must be two (2) pages in length.
- Entries must be typewritten in print no smaller than size 12 font.
- Submit two (2) copies of the narrative, one with the candidate's name and institution and one without any identifying information of the nominee, nominator, or institution.
- Selections will be made by blind review of the narratives.

Please identify <u>specific</u> examples of the criteria that reflect behavior above and beyond a job description. You may include additional examples of achievements under "Other." **Address as many listed criteria as possible**, emphasizing those characteristics that make your candidate unique.
